







COVID-19 RELATED MORTALITY



Note: The above data has followed the methodology of the PHE indicator for 'Deaths within 28 days of a positive COVID-19 test' since reporting for week ending 30th October and is therefore not comparable to reports prior to that week. The figures are still derived using a local live data source and so will therefore not exactly match the number of deaths officially reported by the Office for National Statistics or the PHE Coronavirus Tracker. Further validation of the external data sources with fully coded dates has now led to changes in the numbers reported.


To allow data to be seen accurately, the chart only shows data from 1st July (just before original lockdown measures were removed (6 July 2020); this includes the peak of the first wave (April

Note: The peak date for hospital occupancy was in April 2020 with 131 confirmed COVID-19 patients in beds (peak number of ICU beds occupied by COVID-19 patients was 9 in the 'first wave', which was surpassed on 7th November (n=10)). It should also be noted that the ITU/HDU beds (orange) are a subset of 'any acute beds' (blue), e.g. on 9th October there 64 beds occupied by COVID-19 confirmed patients, 3 of these were in ITU/HDU beds.
