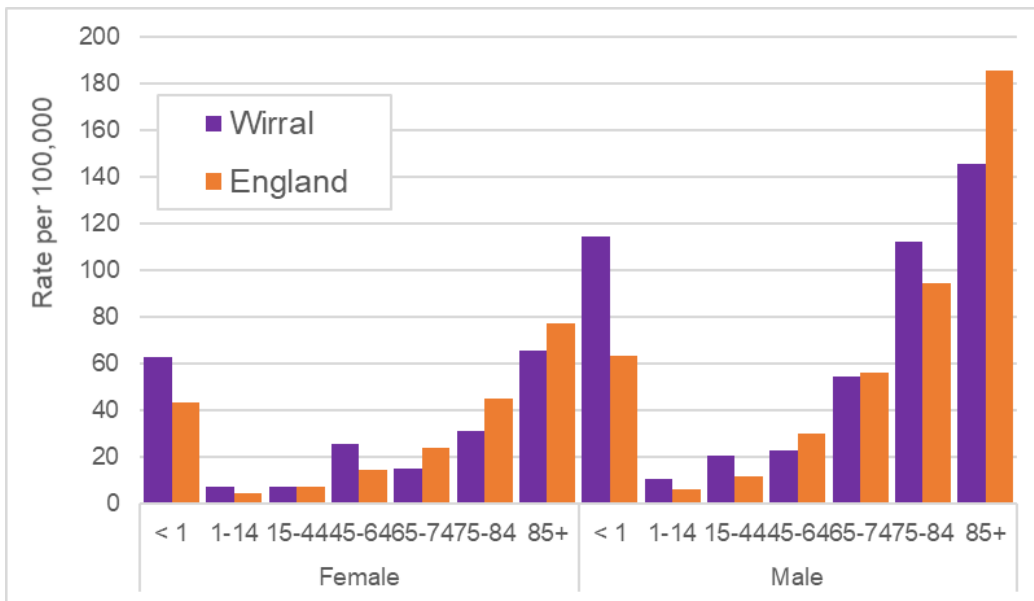


26 people out of every **100,000** will acquire MSSA

The number of cases in Wirral in 2018/19 was

82



The rate of MSSA infections typically increases with age.

Those aged 85+ years have the greatest risk in both, Wirral and England.

73% of MSSA Bacteraemia cases in Wirral are **community-onset** (occur less than 2 days after admission); 38% females and 62% males



93% of people who acquired MSSA Bacteraemia in Wirral **live at home** (compared to 4% who reside in a nursing/residential home)

95% of MSSA Bacteraemia cases in Wirral occurred in patients who have been **admitted via emergency methods** (2% of admission methods were unknown)
