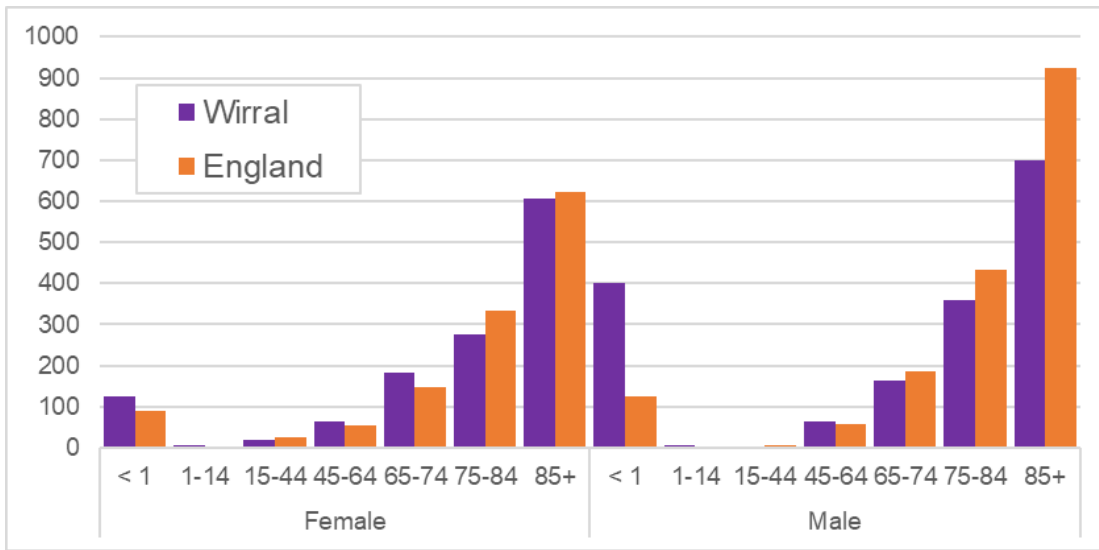


E. coli Bacteraemia Wirral 2018/19

81 people out of every 100,000 will acquire an *E. coli* bacteraemia

The number of cases in Wirral for 2018/19 was

279



The rate of *E. coli* bacteraemia infections typically increases with age. Those aged 85+ years are the most at risk in both Wirral and England

75% of *E. coli* Bacteraemia cases in Wirral are **community-onset** (occur less than 2 days after admission, 54% females and 46% males)



84% of people who acquired *E. coli* Bacteraemia in Wirral **live at home** (compared to 13% who reside in a nursing/residential home)

94% of *E. coli* Bacteraemia cases in Wirral occurred in patients who have been **admitted via emergency methods** (2% of admission methods were unknown)
