








The rate of E. Coli bacteraemia infections typically increases with age. Those aged 85+ years are the most at risk in both Wirral and England

75%

of E. coli Bacteraemia cases in Wirral are **community-onset** (occur less than 2 days after admission, 54% females and 46% males)





of people who acquired E. coli Bacteraemia in Wirral live at home nursing/residential home)

of E. coli Bacteraemia cases in Wirral occurred in patients who have been admitted via emergency methods (2% of admission methods were unknown)
